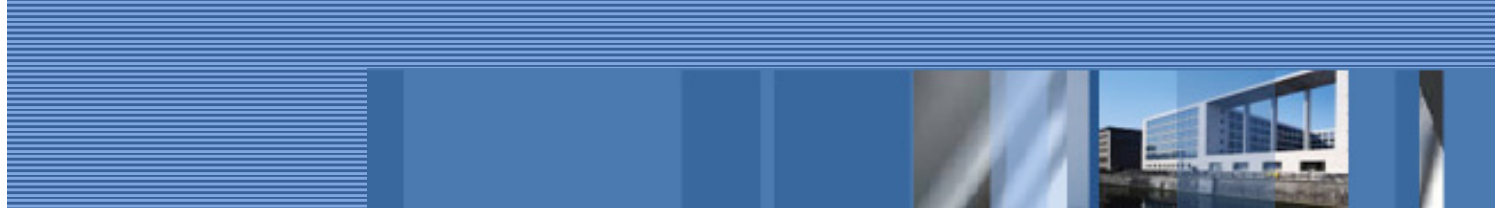

# Green Central Asia

## *Climate and Security in Central Asia and Afghanistan*

- ▶ **Political dialogue** on climate induced security threats in Central Asia and AFG (water, glaciers, land, energy, and others)
  - ▶ Level: Ministries of Foreign Affairs
  - ▶ building on CA Water Initiative ("Berlin Process")
- ▶ **Based on scientific data** (climate risk analysis/foresight)
- ▶ implementing partners: GIZ, PIK, GFZ, DKU
- ▶ time frame: 4 to 5 years, beginning 2020
- ▶ Aim: regional coordination in CA and AFG
- ▶ **Coordination** and **coherence** with EU & partners



- ▶ GCA ties in with goals of new **EU-Central Asia Strategy** to strengthen resilience and foster regional cooperation, as well as with **EU Asia Connectivity Strategy**
- ▶ In CA: steadily improving climate for **cooperation in the region**
- ▶ Some signs of improvement of management of **joint resources**
- ▶ General willingness to tackle **challenges** in political mechanisms for dialogue
- ▶ GCA is a **highly inclusive** and open process
