EU Clean Air policy

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Air pollution in the EU

EU air quality is improving. Emissions have decreased substantially. Still, there are, in the EU:

Health impacts:	Around 400 000 premature deaths each year
Economic impacts:	More than € 24 billion per year in direct costs
Environmental impacts:	Eutrophication limits exceeded in 63% of ecosystem area in the EU, and in 73% of Natura2000 area

SETTING OBJECTIVES FOR GOOD AIR QUALITY

Ambient Air Quality Directives

Maximum concentrations of air polluting substances (PM₁₀, PM_{2.5}, SO₂, NO₂, CO, O₃ + 6 more)

REDUCING EMISSIONS OF POLLUTANTS



National Emission Ceilings Directive

National emission totals (SO₂, NO_x, VOC, PM_{2.5}, NH₃)








Pollutants covered by EU National Emission Ceilings legislation and 2030 targets











Source-specific performance standards: examples

Industrial Emission Directive, Industrial Emissions Performance Standards Ecodesign and Eco-Label standards, BATs and BREFs, ...

Medium Combustion Plants Directive addresses installations at 1-50 MW, setting fuel-specific emission limit values (focus on SO_2 , NO_x and PM), ...

Road transport including type approval standards, real driving emission tests, Euro 6 standards, ...

Non-Road Mobile Machinery (NRMM Directive) type approval standards, fuel quality standards (e.g. sulphur in liquid fuels) to reduce shipping emissions, ...

CLRTAP + Gothenburg Protocol

- UNECE Convention on Long-range Transboundary Air Pollution and linked task forces and knowledge centres guidelines, manuals for assessments, data analysis; guidelines for cost-efficient countermeasures, etc.
- The 1999 Protocol to Abate Acidification, Eutrophication and Ground-level Ozone (equivalent to EU NEC Directive)
- Ratification and implementation of the Convention and its protocols → reducing health and environmental impacts in a more cost-effective way than with unilateral action
