

2030 FRAMEWORK FOR CLIMATE AND ENERGY


EU Nationally Determined Contribution: 40% emission reduction target






EMISSION REDUCTION TARGETS ETS AND NON-ETS

EMISSION REDUCTIONS IN ETS AND NON-ETS COMPARED TO 2005







Free allocation and carbon leakage


EU ETS strengthening

Low-carbon funds



EU ETS STRENGTHENING

Faster annual decline of emission allowances





FREE ALLOCATION / CARBON LEAKAGE

➤ To safeguard the competitiveness of European industry, free allocation of (a limited number of) allowances to sectors at risk of relocating their production outside the EU ('carbon leakage') will continue.

Main features:

- 1. Free allocation 'buffer'
 - Conversion of auction volume into free allocation
- 2. Focus on sectors at highest risk of relocating their production outside the EU around 50 sectors in total
- 3. Indirect cost compensation remains possible



LOW-CARBON FUNDING MECHANISMS

1) Innovation Fund

Support breakthrough technologies in industries as well as carbon capture and storage (CCS) and renewables

2) Modernisation Fund

Support modernisation of energy systems and just transition in 10 lower income Member States


3) Article 10c derogation (optional)

Support modernisation of energy sector through free allocation to the power sector in 10 lower income Member States
