Target 75% of ADB's of the number of committed operations (on a 3-year rolling average) will support climate mitigation and adaptation by 2030



Target Climate finance from ADB's own resources reach \$80 billion (2019-2030)



Climate Change Impact in the Region

- Increased temperature and more variable precipitation and increased droughts and flooding
- Change in river flows due to temperatures and precipitation changes and loss of glacial ice
- Impacts are diverse: agriculture, energy, ecosystem services, transportation, water supply/sanitation, and health
- Potential massive economic impacts with related political and social implications such as migration
- Water investments, planning and policies must urgently prioritize and mainstream climate change, adaptation and resilience










Will river flows increase or decrease?



Steps involved in developing initial activities

- Consolidate feedback from the regional consultation and finalize the scoping study
- ➤ Identify 3-4 priority investment and technical assistance initiatives and develop concept papers for further consultation
 - focus initially on 'near-term' activities with regional benefits
 - further explore linkages with ASBP4
- ➤ Engage with regional entities and development partners on institutional cooperation and co-financing arrangements
- Explore access to new funding modalities, e.g. climate finance
