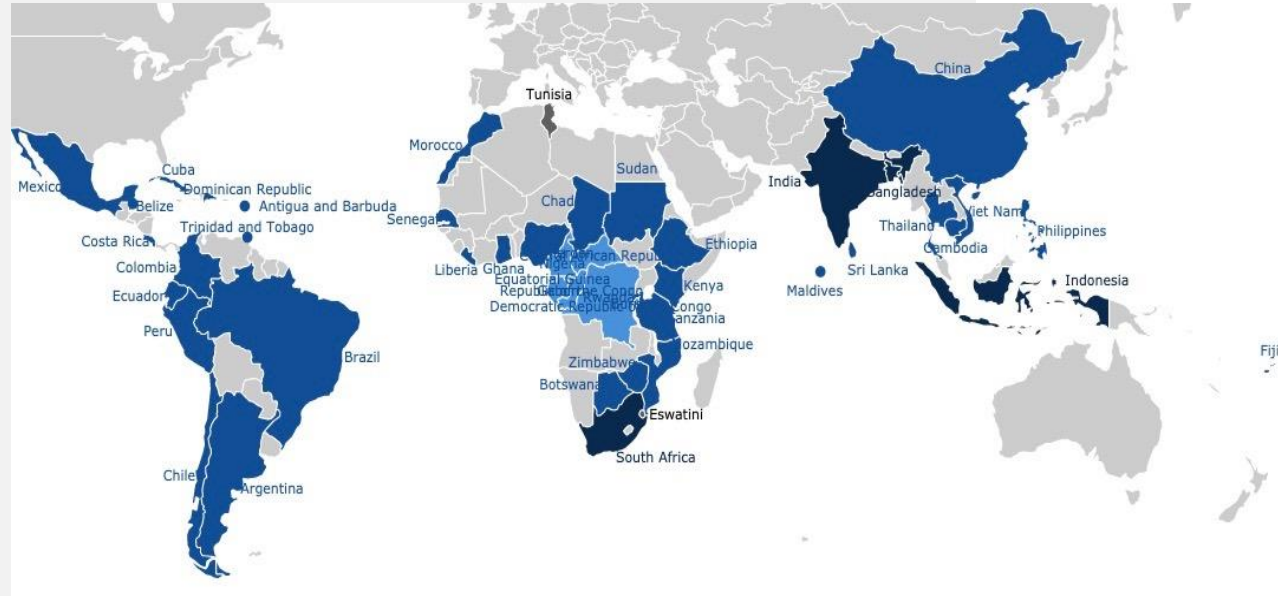

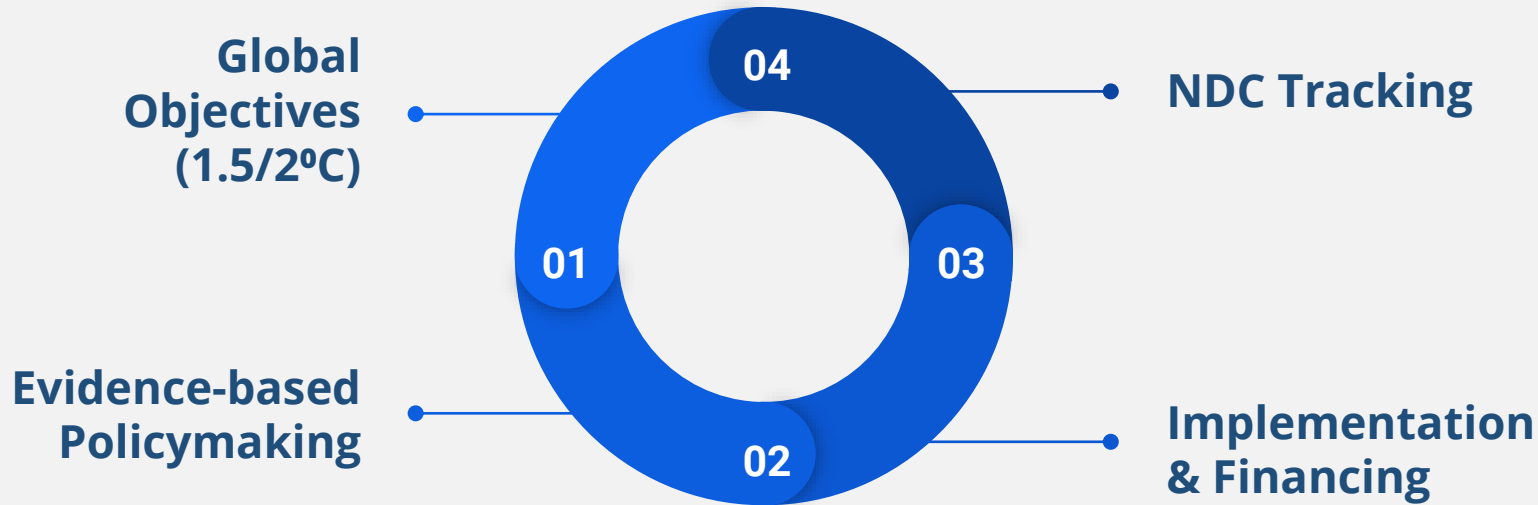
# Initiative for Climate Action Transparency (ICAT)

- 40+ countries in Africa, Asia, Latin America, the Caribbean, and Pacific, ... and soon also Central Asia

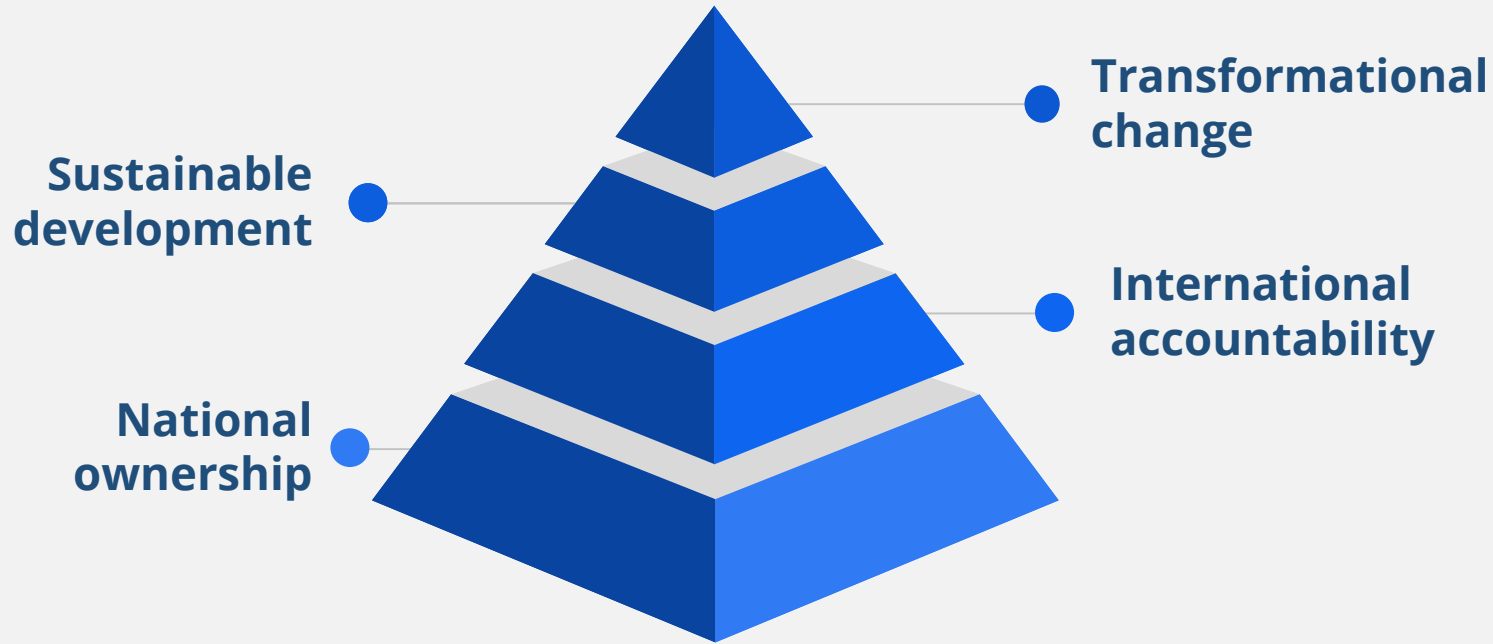

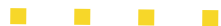
