Central Asia's Environmental Challenges

Central Asia's role is even more critical, not only for its strategic economic position, but also for its crucial natural resources on the one hand, and the acute environmental pressures on the other

- a crossroad of culture, economy, social challenges and great opportunities for international cooperation and sustainable development.
- the place where it is more urgent and challenging to implement concrete actions to tackle climate change with a thorough and holistic approach successfully.

CAREC for green development in CA

- Supports building of sustainable and comprehensive climate action transparency systems
- Initiates establishment of regional mechanism for working with Green Climate Fund
- Facilitates development of project ideas, concepts and portfolio
- Organizes regional dialogues: CACCC, Env.Forum, CALP,
- Establishment and long term supporting regional working groups: climate change, WEFE Nexus, Water quality, Education, parliamentarians and diplomats...
- Development of regional knowledge hub CACIP
- Implementation of regional projects to develop capacities, promote and pilot new approaches
