Our Programme in a nutshell

Launched in **2007**, covering 30+ countries across **Asia**, the **Middle-East** and the **Pacific** (M-E & Pacific as of 2023)

<u>Mission:</u> support the transition of the region to a <u>low-carbon</u>, resource efficient and circular economy, whilst promoting more sustainable supply chains and products between the region and Europe.

<u>Economic sectors:</u> key (export-led) value chains in the region >> agri-food, textiles and leather, plastics, constructions, tourism.

<u>EU policy alignment</u>: support the implementation of the external dimension of the <u>EU Green Deal</u> (Circular Economy Action Plan, Farm to Fork Strategy, EU Strategy for Textiles, EU Plastics Strategy, Corporate Sustainable Due Diligence Directive, EU Sustainable Products Initiative, CBAM (if extended to other economic sectors) and the <u>Global Gateway</u> (supporting the integration and resilience of value chains between Europe and the region).

How do we work



At project level: Through the Grant Scheme, SWITCH-Asia supports collaborative projects of organizations from the EU and the region in demonstrating SCP and circular practices in SMEs and among consumers (at date: ca. 140 projects).

Strong priority: ensure linkages with IFIs to provide access to finance to SMEs to integrate SCP solutions tested through EU grants.

At policy level: The outcomes of projects feed into policy dialogue to influence national and regional policies and regulatory frameworks for the promotion of a greener and more circular economy in the region.

Coordination mechanism with focal points in EU Delegations and in each government in the region. Strong collaboration with international and regional environmental platforms and organisations (e.g. CAREC, ASEAN, ASEAN CSR Network, UN, etc.).






SWITCH-Asia - Phase III

GRANTS SCHEME

Through its Grant Scheme, the Programme will continue supporting collaborative projects between European and Asian organisations aiming at testing and uptake of SCP practices in MSMEs and by consumers (including institutional ones).



POLICY SUPPORT COMPONENT

The outcomes of projects – grants and technical advisory - will feed into policy dialogue to design & improve national / regional policies and regulatory frameworks and to include SCP concerns into Nationally Determined Contributions.


